Tiny Plays, Big Ideas – Theatre Workshops and Performance
25th February, 4th March, 25th March

This year we are again hoping to give every child the opportunity to gain a broader experience of Theatre and we are very excited to have gained a place on the Tiny Plays, Big Ideas Project run by the Theatre Royal in Bury St Edmunds.

The children will take part in 2 workshops in school on Tuesday 25th February and Tuesday 4th March. These will be led by Kitty Morgan the professional playwright who has written the stage version of The Highwayman which is currently touring. These workshops will teach them how to write short plays.

After this, they will submit their plays to the Theatre Royal and one play from each of the 10 schools involved in the Project will be performed by the Theatre Company. The class are invited to visit the Theatre Royal to watch this performance.

The Theatre has covered the cost of the project and given a bursary towards the cost of travel but we do need to ask for a donation of £8 per child to cover the remaining cost of the coach transport to and from the Theatre Royal. This is available to pay under 'Trips' on Arbor.

The Performance is on **Tuesday 25th March at 2pm**. The children will have an early lunch at school before travelling to the Theatre Royal. We hope to return to school by **4pm**.
